### Eligibility Requirements:

- \*2026 Fayette County graduating senior, entering college or Technical School or current college student
- \*GPA minimum 2.7 (copy of transcript must be attached)
- \* Household income not to exceed \$50,000/year (proof required)
- \* **Living in Southern Fayette County – Piperton, Rossville, Moscow, or south of Hwy 196.**

### Procedure for submitting application:

- High School Transcript
- ACT Scores
- Proof of admission to the college/university/ technical school you will be attending.
- Proof of income from your parents – one month of pay stubs, tax return or a W-2 form. If both parents are employed full time, both are required.
- Those interested in a music scholarship are asked to provide information about musical background.
- List your school and community involvement within the last year including any clubs or service projects. As a part of this section, please provide 3 – 4 sentences about an experience that made an impression on you.
- Submit an essay of at least 200 words explaining what you would like to accomplish with a degree. Please use the following writing prompts in your essay.

Here are some prompts to assist you as you prepare your essay.

- 1. Make a list of the things you want to accomplish— and why.*
- 2. Examples--Who inspired/challenged you in high school - teachers, parents, older student, etc.*
- 3. If there is a specific situation that inspired or challenged you— explaining the situation will make your essay more interesting and coming from the heart not just the brain. You may have more than one situation so your introduction can be general and then give specifics of the people and events in the second paragraph.*
- 4. The conclusion can then be about seeing yourself as a college student and thankful for the help you received in high school.*
